This practice is important to support the company's financial stability through transparent and efficient financial transaction management. Data is taken from daily cash flow transactions, purchase orders, and tax invoice reports, which are then processed using Microsoft Excel. The focus of this profession's work includes recording and inputting financial data such as company income and expenses, managing purchase orders, and processing tax invoices from tax consultants. During the implementation of the work, several obstacles were found such as the quality of unclear transaction evidence and the absence of standard templates for data recording.
