PROFESSIONAL WORK ACTIVITIES AS AN HR ADMINISTRATOR IN THE GARMENT INDUSTRY AT KONVEKSI TOKO ABI (KOTABI)

This internship report is based on the student's experience during the professional work program at Konveksi Toko Abi (KOTABI), a company engaged in garment manufacturing services, specifically within the Human Capital Division. The objective of this program was for the student to apply theories and concepts gained during academic studies into real-world practice, particularly in the area of human resource administration. During the internship, the student encountered several challenges, including limited access to internal company documents, difficulties in adapting to the work rhythm, and a mismatch between assigned tasks and academic background.
