PROFESSIONAL WORK ACTIVITIES IN THE HUMAN CAPITAL BUSINESS PARTNER DIVISION AT PT. PERTAMINA TRANS KONTINENTAL

The Professional Work (KP) program is a learning initiative by Universitas Pembangunan Jaya aimed at providing students with work experience in fields relevant to their major. The intern carried out the professional work program in the Human Capital Business Partner division at PT Pertamina Trans Kontinental. PT Pertamina Trans Kontinental is an Indonesian company engaged in maritime services, established on September 9, 1969.
