

ABSTRACT

THE EFFECT OF INTELLECTUAL CAPITAL, COMPANY SIZE AND INFLATION ON COMPANY VALUE (Empirical Study On Infrastructure Sector Companies Listed On the Indonesia Stock Exchange for the Period 2020-2023)

This study aims to analyze the effect of Intellectual Capital, Company Size, and Inflation on Firm Value in infrastructure sector companies listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange during the period 2020-2023. This research is motivated by fluctuations in the value of companies in the infrastructure sector which are influenced by the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic. The approach used in this research is quantitative, with secondary data obtained from the company's annual report. The sample selection was carried out by purposive sampling, which included 29 infrastructure companies with a total of 166 observations. Data analysis was performed using multiple linear regression using Eviews 13 software. The results of this study are expected that intellectual capital, company size, and inflation have an effect both partially and simultaneously on firm value. It is hoped that the results of this study can contribute to the development of academic studies on the factors that influence firm value in the infrastructure sector, as well as a reference for investors and management in making strategic decisions.
