## The Effect of Resilience on Family Satisfaction in Adolescents with **Divorced Parents**

The role of parents is very important for adolescents. The closeness of parents can make adolescents have family satisfaction. If adolescents have high family satisfaction, it will help them accept their life circumstances or resilience. Resilience is one factor that can effect family satisfaction. This study aims to determine whether there is an effect of resilience on family satisfaction in adolescents with divorced parents. Respondents in this study were 363 adolescents with divorced parents. This study used a quantitative method with data analysis techniques using four assumption tests and logistic regression tests. The instruments used in this study were the Satisfaction With Family Life Scale (SWFL) and Confirmatory Factor Analysis of the 10-item Connor-Davidson Resilience Scale (CD-RISC). The results of this study indicate a significant positive effect of resilience on family satisfaction in adolescents with divorced parents. The research shows that adolescents with divorced parents who have resilience will have higher family satisfaction.
