The Influence of Executive Character and Political Connections on Potential Tax Avoidance (Empirical Study on State-Owned Enterprises Listed on the IDX 2017-2019)

This study aims to examine the Effect of Executive Character and Political Connections on Tax Avoidance Potential (Empirical Study on State-Owned Enterprises Listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange 2017-2019). The population in this study is in the sector of state-owned companies listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) in 2017-2019 as many as 24 companies. The sample was determined using the purposive sampling method, with a total sample of 60 samples consisting of 20 companies that met the criteria for determining the sample.
