This Unbelievable miniseries tells the true story of a serial rape that occurred in America in 2000. The scene conveyed through this Unbelievable miniseries message is the silence of the rape victim experienced by Marie Adler who lives in an apartment and is raped by an unknown man. This incident also occurred in other cities with the same perpetrator. This study aims to determine the message of silence of rape victims in the miniseries 'Unbelievable' by adult men. This research uses descriptive qualitative method with reception analysis. Based on the results of interviews with the three informants, the three informants are in a dominant-hegemonic reading position, meaning that the informant interprets the message conveyed in the Unbelievable miniseries story to find out what attitude should be taken when someone is a victim of rape. In this study, there were no potential readings and negotiated readings
