ABSTRACT

THE ETHNIC IDENTITY DIFFERENCES JAVANESE TRANSMIGRANTS WHO MARRIED A COMMUNITY ETHNIC BETWEEN THE ONE WHO MARRIED TO LAMPUNG ETHNIC IN LAMPUNG PROVINCE

Lampung province has become one of the transmigration places for Javanese people from 1905, until now the Javanese people are the majority among other tribes in the province of Lampung with a population of 5 million people. The existence of diverse cultures can lead to intercultural marriages between Javanese and Lampung tribes. This Javanese tribe is known as a tribe that has a variety of cultures and traditions. Javanese individuals who marry ethnic Lampung have been influenced by the culture of their partner or place of residence so that they no longer continue Javanese culture and traditions, otherwise Javanese individuals who marry other ethnic groups still practice Javanese culture and traditions. The purpose of this research to see if there are differences in ethnic identity between Javanese individuals who are married to other ethnic groups and Javanese individuals who are married to Lampung ethnic groups. The results of this research show U = 19309.500 (p = <0,001) which means there are differences in ethnic identity between Javanese individuals who marry other ethnic groups and Javanese individuals who marry ethnic Lampung, this is it due to the value of p < 0.05 with a significance of 0.001 so that the alternative hypothesis (Ha) can be accepted.
