

## ABSTRACT

### ***The Meaning of 100 Percent Face-to-Face Learning Policy News on Kompas.com (Analysis of Receptions for Mothers in the Depok City Area)***

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The news about the 100 Percent Face-to-Face Learning (PTM) policy triggers pros and cons. The policy that was ratified through the Letter of Joint Interest of the 4 Ministers concerning Guidelines for the Implementation of Learning in a Pandemic Period has become a serious polemic for the phenomenon of education in Indonesia. One of them was in the news on Kompas.com with the title "Pros and Cons of 100 Percent Face-to-Earth Learning in Schools, What are the Opinions of Parents" which was published on January 10, 2022. The report explained that a statement from the West Java Provincial Education Office asked for Learning Face to face (PTM) 100 Percent postponed in a number of areas, especially Depok due to the increase in PPKM status at level 2. This policy was also responded to by a number of parents who wanted 100 Percent PTM to be carried out immediately based on strict health protocols. This study used research methods qualitative and using reception analysis method. The results of this study indicate that the position of the informant's meaning of preferred reading in the message content of the 100 Percent Face-to-face Learning Policy News by Mothers in the Depok City area shows that there is a dominant hegemonic reading and negotiated reading position. In Informant 2, Informant 3 and Informant 4 are in the dominant hegemonic reading position. Informant 1 is in a negotiated reading position. The interesting thing in this study is that there is no optional reading position. This face-to-face learning policy has a preferred reading, which is supported by parents because home learning is taking too long and communication between students and teachers triggers ineffectiveness, so 100 percent face-to-face learning must also be carried out with strict health protocols. Most of the informants of this study stated the same meaning. This means that the informants of this research produce the meaning of dominant hegemony reading.
