The Cruella's film tells a story about the childhood trauma whom experienced by women in childhood and how the Impact in adulthood. Trauma is generally an pressure emotional and psychological stress caused by unpleasant events or experiences related to violence that has potential to cause an excessive stress. This film also discusses several psychological aspects such as childhood trauma and the impact on an adult woman who has a trauma in her childhood that can affect her behavior and actions in the future. This study to identify and describe the depiction of female characters with childhood trauma in the film with uses a qualitative content analysis method to analyze the forms of childhood trauma and the impact on adult women in the Cruella's film. The results and conclusions found by the researcher are that this film does not only show the villain side of the main character in the film but also contains educational messages about childhood trauma and its impact on adults. The comparison of scenes containing elements of childhood trauma and childhood non-trauma in the Cruella's film are 18% and 82%, respectively. The comparison of scenes containing elements of the impact of childhood trauma and non-impact of childhood trauma in the Cruella's film is 21% and 79%, respectively. The types of childhood trauma found in Estella's character are Emotional Abuse and Mental Illness and the impacts experienced include emotional impacts and mental impacts shown in the Cruella's film.
