OBJECTIVITY OF THE WABU BLOCK CONFLICT NEWS (Content Analysis Quantitative on Wabu Block Conflict Reports on Kompas.com and Detik.com Online News Portals for the Period August 2021 - March 2022)

This study measures the objectivity of Kompas.com and Detik.com media in reporting the Wabu Block conflict involving Luhut Binsar Pandjaitan with Haris Azhar and Fatia Maulidiyanti regarding prosecution for defamation, false reporting, and spreading slander with 40 news stories in the period August 2021 - March 2022. This study uses the Quantitative Content Analysis method with the Rachma Ida model using 3 dimensions, namely Accuracy, Impartiality, and Validity. The results of this study indicate Detik.com in reporting on the Wabu Block conflict is superior to Kompas.com. It was found that 85% by Detik.com did not have a mixture of facts and opinions, while on Kompas.com it was found that 70%. In terms of impartiality, it was found that 45% of the news reports by Detik.com did not side with one side related to the conflict, while Kompas.com was 40%. In its reputation, the print media Kompas is known to be very objective. However, it is different in the online media Kompas.com because in reporting on the Blok Wabu Conflict the results found are not objective
