FRAMEWORK OF ENVIRONMENT POLICY ISSUES IN THE COPYRIGHT LAW (Comparison of News Framing of Development Policy Issues and Their Impact on the Environment between Mongabay.co.id and Antaranews.com)

The Job Creation Act or Law No. 11 on job creation, is a law made by the government in order to advance the economy and accelerate development in Indonesia. However, the existence of the Job Creation Law has drawn a lot of controversy, one of which is the controversy on environmental issues. Controversy over environmental policy issues contained in the Job Creation Act often becomes news in the online media. This study seeks to explain how the framing of environmental policy issues in the Job Creation Act. News from the two media, Antaranews.com and Mongabay.co.id for the period February 2020-December 2020 were analyzed using the Pan and Kosicki model framing method. The aim is to see how the description of environmental policy issues in the Job Creation Act is framed by the two media. The results of the study found that Antaranews.com and Mongabay.co.id described the environmental policy issues contained in the Job Creation Act in different ways. Antaranews.com frames the environmental policy issue in the Job Creation Act by reporting on the good impacts of the Job Creation Act on environmental and economic permits. On the other hand, Mongabay.co.id chooses to report on the negative impacts of the Job Creation Act. to the environment in the future.
