Internal Quality Audit Goes Remote: Because Rome Was Not Built in a Day

A. Project Background

Why did I choose this project? My reason was straight-forward: the virus made me do this. Covid-19 pandemic required physical distance. Since March 2020, Universitas Pembangunan Jaya (UPJ) and all universities in Indonesia made the sudden leaps onto online realms. Digital savvy lecturers became Youtubers in a snap - releasing a series of teaching materials to social media platforms and cultivating a number of followers. On the other side of the coin were struggling professors.

No choice, we had to transform – this included quality assurance. In the national level, we witnessed how National Accreditation Agency for Higher Education since June 2020 jumped into online settings with their Online Assessment.

In terms of accreditation, specifically on urgency, it was safe to say that UPJ was doing just fine. In terms of quality documents, UPJ was well-equipped. All ten study programmes raised to grade B in 2017-2019 and in 2018 UPJ managed to obtain grade B for university-level accreditation. Since January 2020, Minister Nadiem Makarim introduced 'auto-accreditation' policies which could be utilized to extend its grade B. Moreover, last September 2020 UPJ celebrated its 9th anniversary with sweet surprise – securing its 92nd national rank in
