## **ABSTRACT**

FRAMING OF NEWS COVERAGE ON SEXUAL VIOLENCE IN UNIVERSITIES (A Framing Analysis of News Coverage on Sexual Violence in Universities on Kompas.com and Tempo.co Portals, November 2021-December 2022)

The increase in cases of sexual violence in the university environment from November 2021 to December 2022 has drawn media attention, including news portals. This research aims to depict the framing of news coverage on sexual violence in universities on the portals Kompas.com and Tempo.co during the period of November 2021 to December 2022 using the concept of online journalism, news, gender-based journalism, and media construction of reality. The study analyzes 10 news articles from each news portal that focus on sexual violence by lecturers against female students. The framing analysis method developed by Zhongdang Pan and Gerald M. Kosicki is utilized in this research to analyze the selected news articles. The findings of this study indicate that Kompas.com reports on cases of sexual violence in universities cautiously, providing detailed chronology, case developments, and efforts made by relevant parties. On the other hand, Tempo.co tends to emphasize events in the coverage of sexual violence in universities through a brief description of the chronology, case development, and efforts made by relevant parties in monitoring these case of sexual violence in universities.
