FRAMING OF PAPUA GOVERNOR'S CORRUPTION NEWS ON ONLINE NEWS PORTALS (Framing Analysis on News on Kompas.com and Kabarpapua.co for the period September 2022 – January 2023)

This study aims to analyze the framing of news about corruption cases involving the Governor of Papua on Kompas.com and Kabarpapua.co news portals, in the period September 2022 – January 2023. Framing analysis of Zhongdang Pan & Gerald M. Kosicki was used in this study. This research uses a qualitative approach with a constructivism paradigm. This research focuses on knowing how different news framing on the two portals. The research findings show a significant difference in the framing of news related to Governor Lukas Enembe. Kompas.com prefers framing that focuses on events or events surrounding the determination of suspect status and the arrest of Lukas Enembe by the Komisi Pemberantasan Korupsi (KPK). In this framing, Kompas.com presents polemics and responses from various figures in one news. On the other hand, Kabarpapua.co focuses more on framing news on efforts to create security and peace in Papua through statements from related parties in the case of Lukas Enembe. The framing of news by Kabarpapua.co emphasizes the description of events by one of the figures directly involved and represents the authority to convey clarifying information or appeals. This research provides a better understanding of the differences in news framing between the two online news portals that were the subject of the study. The results of this study can be useful in recognizing how the media can influence public perceptions and assessments of corruption cases involving figures.
