Individuals who violate the law will serve a prison sentence, the individual will change social status to receive compensation. While undergoing a period of imprisonment for compensation, they experience problems and changes related to emotions. Emotional intelligence traits play a role in serving prison time. This research aims to determine the description of the nature of emotional intelligence in compensation at the Cipinang Class 1 Correctional Institution. The respondents for this research were 350 prisoners. This research uses quantitative methods, with data analysis techniques using descriptive statistics and normality tests. The descriptive statistics that will be calculated include the empirical mean, theoretical mean value, minimum value and also maximum value. The instrument used in this research was the Trait Emotional Intelligence.
