

## ABSTRACT

### **Description of College Adjustment for Overseas Students on the Island of Java**

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Nowadays, people have increasingly easier opportunities to migrate, this condition is supported by advances in the automotive sector, infrastructure and private vehicle ownership. There are many goals that can encourage someone to migrate. One of the goals is someone who leaves their homeland to pursue higher education such as becoming a student. Migrant students are students who migrate to study, these students leave their hometown and live independently facing all different situations and environmental conditions that are different from their hometown. Being an overseas student has its own challenges, namely needing to adapt to an environment with something new such as culture, language and food. Students' ability to adapt to college and face the demands that occur in their lives is an explanation of College Adjustment developed by Baker. This research was carried out to see a picture of College Adjustments for students from outside Java who continue their education on the island of Java. The subjects of this research were 385. The research instrument used the Student Adaptation to College Questionnaire (SACQ). Based on the results of descriptive data analysis, this research found that College Adjustment among students from outside Java who continued their education on Java tended to be high. This research shows that students from outside Java who continue their education on the island of Java have good adaptability to higher education.
