ABSTRACT

The Description of Adversity Quotient among KIP Scholarship Recipients

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The Kartu Indonesia Pintar (KIP) Scholarship Program, which is one of the ways to help individuals who experience financial difficulties in pursuing higher education, is supported by government aid. Of course, there are certain expectations that KIP scholarship recipients must fulfill, such as maintaining a certain GPA and completing their studies within a certain timeframe. The presence of difficulties faced by KIP scholarship students requires students to have the ability to manage their circumstances, which is referred to as adversity quotient. This study aims to understand the adversity quotient of KIP scholarship students. The study's respondents numbered 349. The results show that the adversity quotient of KIP scholarship students tends to be high, with most respondents falling into the high category
