This square is more inclusive and accessible to everyone and all sides. For it is possible in making the concept of this square to consider some theories of forming public space. One of these theories is placemaking. In this study researchers are trying to identify the concept of South Tangerang square design using the concept of placemaking approach. This method of study uses qualitative methods by observation and recording based on placemaking theory with 4 main indicators and 33 indicators. Studies have shown that the squares have already capitalized on the concept of placemaking in its design.
