ABSTRACT

ACADEMIC RESILIENCE DIFFERENCES IN HIGH SCHOOL AND VOCATIONAL STUDENTS

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High school and SMK are educational units that are at the level of secondary education that is common in Indonesia, where this level is the preparation level for higher education or work. The increasingly complex and diverse challenges and barriers require students to have strategies to adapt to the problems they face. Being resilient in the academic field becomes an important part of a student's learning process. The results of the Mann-Whitney U Test showed that there was no significant difference between the academic resilience of high school students and small school students, where academic resistance in high school and small college students tended to be high. Analysis using the norms of categorization was also done on this study. The results showed that most high school and SMK students were in the highest category.
